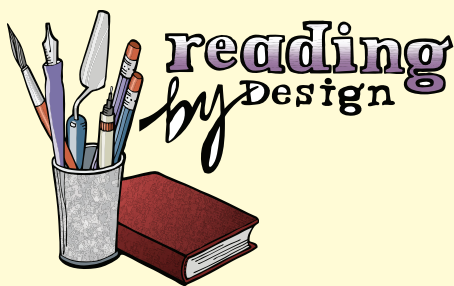
### Abbit the Average

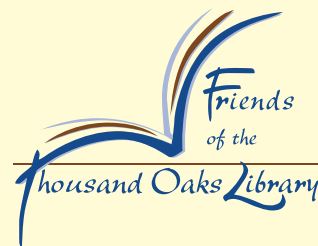

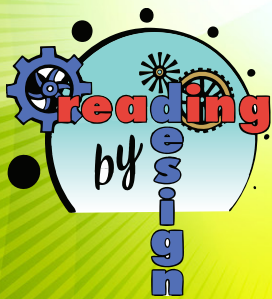
Actor/director Duffy Hudson plays Albert Einstein in a one man show that gives a glimpse into the scientist and his Theory of Relativity. For high school age and up.

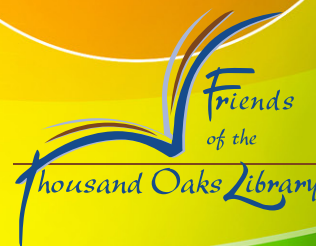

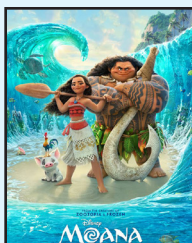
