**Submission of this form constitutes a release to reprint, distribute, and display the attached work by the Thousand Oaks Library.*

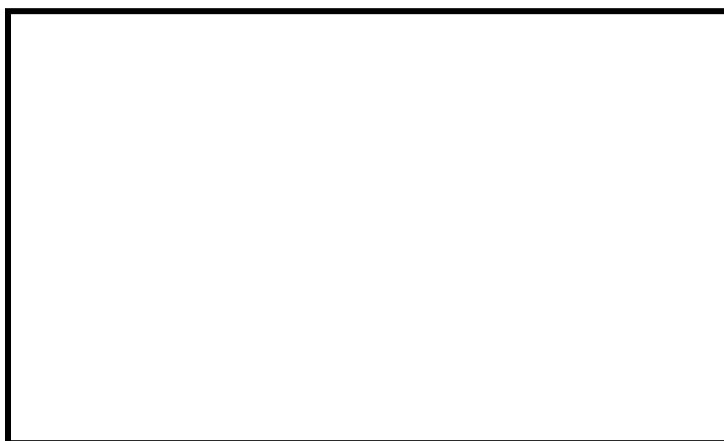
