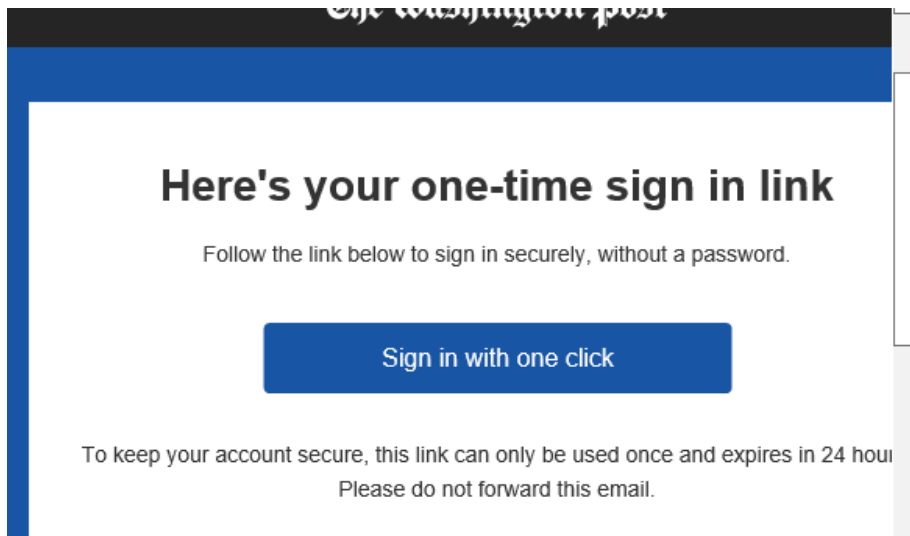

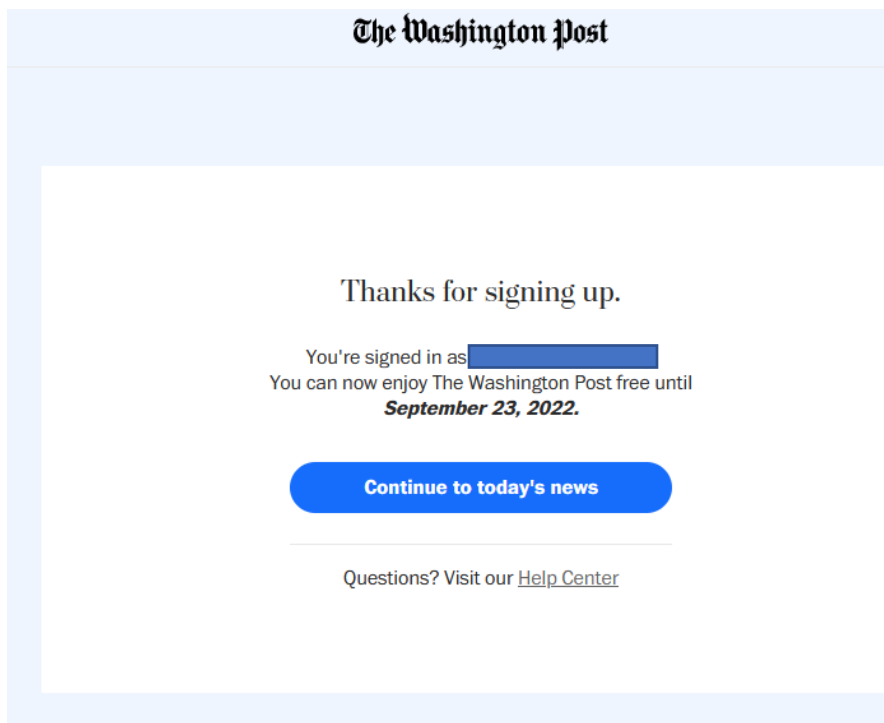
If you already have an account, it should send an email with a limited time link to log in:

And when the password is completed, you should get the same "Continue" screen as with the emailed link, as below.

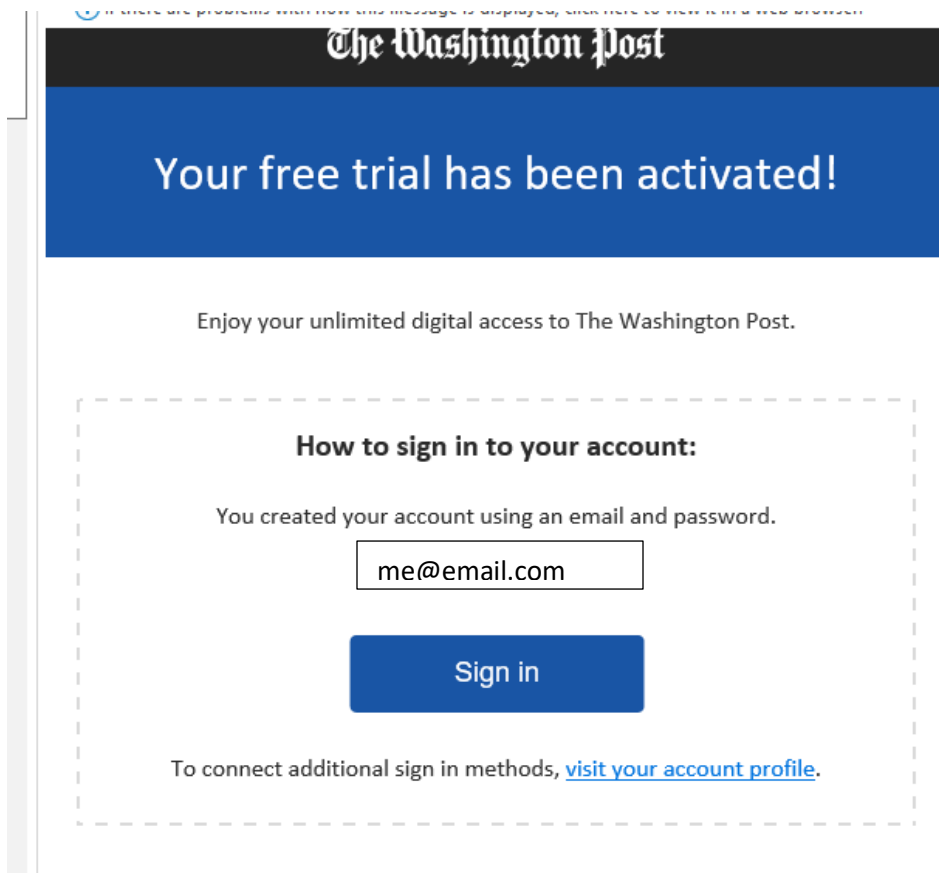


If you click “Continue to today’s news, from that page, you should be able to read the paper:
