


Ruths, Mitali Banerjee Series: The Party Diaries **Awesome Orange Birthday** (bk. 1)


Sachar, Louis Series: Wayside School

The Candy Caper (bk. 1)




Cordell, Matthew Series: Cornbread & Poppy Cornbread & Poppy (bk. 1)

Iwai, Melissa Series: Gigi and Ojiji Gigi and Ojiji (bk. 1)



Messner, Kate Series: Fergus and Zeke



Quigley, Dawn Series: Jo Jo Makoons The Used-To-Be Best Friend (bk. 1)




Katz, Alan Series: S.O.S.: Society of Substitutes


Lyons, Kelly Starling Series: Miles Lewis



When Zookeeper Fred's green snake Vern gets loose in the zoo and lands atop a boy's head, there is trouble! A few citizens demand that all snakes must go and the Mayor closes the zoo. The Questioneers will need all their talents to save the zoo but in the end, it is Aaron's art that leads the way. 154 pp. (Humorous, STEAM)



Bowles, David Series: 13th Street

Battle of the Bad-Breath Bats (bk. 1)

Cousins Malia, Ivan, and Dante are visiting their aunt for the summer. On their way to a water park, they get lost and end up in a strange world filled with dangerous beasts! In order to survive, they must rely on Dante's video game experience, Ivan's creativity, and Malia's leadership. Will they find their way back to Aunt Lucy's? 86 pp. (Horror, Humorous) (420 Lexile, AR = 3.1)



Butler, Dori Hillestad Series: Dear Beast Simon Sleeps Over (bk. 4)

Andy has two pets: a snooty cat, Simon, at his mom's house and a good-natured dog, Baxter, at his dad's house. Simon and Baxter are pen pals until a disastrous sleepover finally brings them together. 80 pp. (Animal Fantasy, Humorous)

Fang, Vicky Series: Layla and the Bots Happy Paws (bk. 1)



Giff, Patricia Reilly Series: Mysteries on Zoo Lane


Meet the Crew at the Zoo (bk. 1)

Griffith, Theanne Series: The Magnificent Makers **How to Test a Friendship** (bk. 1)


